

## **Prim Stadium Rules and Regulations for SSMS Students**

In an effort to provide our students, faculty, and visitors with a safe and enjoyable environment, SSISD has the following policies in regards to our facility.

**Middle School** students need to be seated in the following areas:

1. at SSHS events (Friday night football games) with an adult or seated in the middle school bleacher section located at the south end of the field.
2. at SSMS events (Thursday night football games) in the bleachers.

### **Student behavior expectations:**

1. Middle school students sitting in their own section at the football game are expected to act in accordance with general behavioral guidelines.
  - a. Throwing objects of any kind in the stands (candy, paper, cans, bottles, balls, etc.) is **NOT** acceptable.
  - b. Students should show respect by being quiet when the band plays the National Anthem and during the student led prayer.
  - c. Students' clothing must be modest and appropriate. Clothing that exposes a student's midriff or that is too low cut and/or revealing is not allowed.
  - d. Students need to choose a place to sit and remain seated throughout the game. Running up and down the bleachers with friends is not acceptable.

### **Visiting the restroom or concession stand:**

1. Students visiting the restroom or concession stand area need to promptly return to their seats.
2. Running, tackling, and other horseplay is not allowed as it causes a safety hazard to others in attendance.
3. No loitering under the bleachers or common areas during the football game.

### **Students who fail to adhere to the rules and regulations set forth by SSISD may result in one of the following consequences:**

1. Student(s) may be ejected from the stadium and/or escorted off school property immediately.
2. Student(s) may be subjected to disciplinary consequences as prescribed by their campus administrator.
3. Student(s) may be banned from attending future school events if they continuously fail to follow set policies.
